

Privacy Policy and General Data Protection Regulation Notice

The Classic Corvette Club UK (CCCUK) holds personal data about its members, as supplied by the members. This data is used to process membership, to provide members with information from the CCCUK, to enable CCCUK to carry out membership activities and to provide CCCUK with management and statistical information.

Data protection notice

The CCCUK collects and maintains personal information so that it can carry out its functions as a Club, provide membership services and comply with certain statutory obligations.

The CCCUK treats all personal information with the utmost confidentiality and with appropriate levels of security. By joining the club, members agree to our processing personal information for the purposes outlined in this document.

Personal data will be used for a range of Club-based activities relating to its running. These include member communications, record maintenance, archiving purposes, historical research, statistical purposes, promotion of events & requests for members to help in running of the Club and events.

All information (updated as appropriate) will be kept throughout an individual's time as a member and for such reasonable period (and to the extent necessary) after membership has expired as may be needed.

Personal data will also be made available as and when necessary to our Committee Members, Regional Representatives, Committee Support Staff and authorised sub-contractors within the execution of their roles, responsibilities and contracts where applicable. No data will be released to any other Club Member (such as a phone number or e-mail address) without the prior written approval of the member concerned.

Accessing personal data online

Members can access their own personal data online by logging into MemberMojo. It is the responsibility of each individual member to ensure their own personal data is accurate and up to date. The Club cannot be held responsible for errors in the accuracy of any data provided by the member.

Under the General Data Protection Regulation 2018 (GDPR), CCCUK members also have the right to make a subject access request for a copy of the information the CCCUK holds about them. Requests should be made in writing to the CCCUK Data Protection Officer - a role carried out by the Club Secretary. secretary@corvetteclub.org.uk

Members have the right to complain to the Information Commissioners Office if they think there is a problem with the way their data is being handled by the Club. The CCCUK membership (via MemberMojo) website takes every precaution to protect our members' information. When members' personal and sensitive information is submitted via the website it is protected and backed up regularly to a secure server.

Authorisation

CCCUK does not sell or trade member or organisation information to Third Parties. All emails are sent to members directly from the Club. In order to most efficiently deliver Vette News to members, a data file containing member names and addresses is sent to the printers who delete the data file as soon as the print job is complete and do not keep any member data for longer than 30 days in accordance with GDPR.
