

Probationer Information Guide



Shooting membership categories, includes probationer:

Adult; minimum age 24.

Student; age limited 18-23 years old inc.

Junior; age limited 12-17 years old inc.

Membership fees:

CDRC operates a scheme for probationers which allows a low cost and no commitment entry to the sport of shooting, followed by 2 periods of follow-on training and use of club equipment. This scheme covers all probationers regardless of the shooting discipline you start with:

- ☐ Up to end of first whole month of probationary membership - only range fees and ammunition is payable by the probationer – see below.
- ☐ For second and third whole month period – a £50 Adult, or £25 Junior/Student, membership fee is charged to cover the training the probationer receives. Range fees and ammunition purchase - see below.
- ☐ For fourth, fifth and sixth whole month period - a final £50 Adult, or £25 Junior/Student, membership fee is charged to cover the training the probationer receives. Range fees and ammunition purchase - see below.

For most probationers, the 6 months training period will provide sufficient range time, based on weekly attendance, to achieve the required competency to apply for full membership. If for any reason, the 6 months period is not sufficient, then the club will discuss and agree an alternative approach more suited to your individual situation.

Probationer training evenings:

Probationers may attend the club for training on Tuesday and/or Friday evenings from 7:30PM to 9:30 PM.

Range fees and ammunition purchase:

For each attendance at the probationer training evenings there is a range fee of £5 per visit for Adult membership and £2.50 for Junior/Student memberships. Ammunition can be purchased and stored at the club. Use of all club rifles and pistols, and target cards is included in the range fee.

Membership ID card:

Each probationer will be issued a temporary membership card, a fee of £10 is payable upon issue. This fee covers the future production of the members own photo I/D membership card.

Should the temporary card be lost or damaged, so it is unusable, then a replacement card will be issued for a further £10.

No access to the club is permitted without a membership card.

Once an application has been approved for full membership, the club will issue a photo ID membership card at no additional cost.
