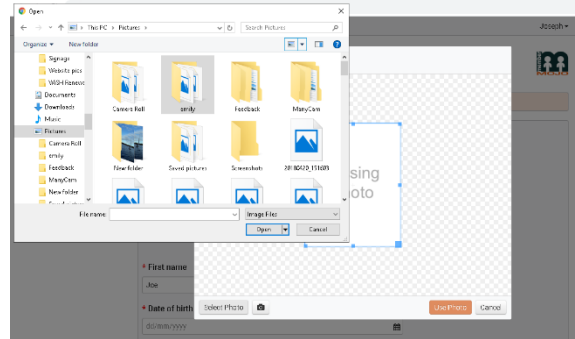

When inserting your boat details you can upload a photo. This will help the boat park officer to identify your boat easily.

You should then choose how many boat berths you would like. – the boat park officer will confirm when spaces are allocated.

At all times and for all activities I accept sole responsibility for myself, my children or wards and my guests and I accept the responsibility for the supervision of same in the Clubhouse, on the grounds and on the water.

I declare that any boat(s) I own is/are insured whilst on Club property, with a reputable company, for third party liability to value of (Defined in club rules).

I further declare that it will remain valid until I remove my boat(s) from Club Premises, and I understand that this also applies to any other boats I might acquire (Additional boat storage should be applied for if required, requests should be made to the membership secretary)

I/we also declare that I/we will comply with any rules/byelaws/policies of the Club that apply at the time.

WISH SC runs by the voluntary efforts of its members and thus it is a condition of membership that all undertake Club Duties (race/galley), usually two or three in a season, as required by the Club. Members where possible are expected to participate in working parties. Club membership is valid from AGM to the next AGM (usually March to March).




Step 6 (Only memberships which include families or Juniors)

If you selected a family membership you will be asked to add details of linked members. This form is much more simple than for the main member. You can add up to 7 linked members at the moment each must be eligible under club rules.

If the family member is another adult they should agree to the club rules themselves and opt in /out of photo consent etc.

If you have applied for Junior member you must provide details of a parent/guardian. A parent/guardian must agree to the junior joining the club.

Step 6 – Summary of details and payment method

In the payment section membermojo will have calculated your fee based on what you selected. Check this carefully as it is easier to change things now than later. When you are happy click checkout. This is the last chance to change your membership category and boat berth so check they are correct.

If you are happy your details are correct, select how you intend to pay and click the “pay with ...” button.

Instructions will be given depending on which payment method you choose.
