TERMS & CONDITIONS

I confirm that I have read and agree to the Terms & Conditions below.

I confirm that the information provided in this membership application is accurate and complete.

You agree to be bound by the Club's Constitution, Policies and Procedures, Codes of Conduct, Player Development philosophy and the FA RESPECT Policy.

As an FA Accredited Club, all members, parents and spectators are expected to represent the Club positively and behave appropriately at all times.

MEMBERSHIP TERMS & CONDITIONS

- No change to the published schedule of membership fees can be authorised by any Team Manager, Coach or other officer without the written agreement of the Club Treasurer or Membership Secretary.
- Membership fees are payable either: In full by 1 September (or upon joining after a trial period), or By approved instalment plan where applicable. • If you have difficulty in making membership payments by the due date, you should inform the Membership Secretary.
- Membership fees are non-refundable in the event that a player chooses to leave the Club during the season.
- In exceptional circumstances where an entire team is unable to continue and folds during the season, the Club may, at its discretion, provide a pro-rata refund of membership fees, less the cost of any kit and other non-recoverable costs already incurred by the Club.
- Any requests for refunds outside of this policy, including exceptional circumstances, must be submitted in writing to the Club Chairman and will be reviewed by the Club Committee at the next scheduled committee meeting. Any decision made by the Committee shall be final.
- The Club reserves the right to suspend training, match participation, membership and/or league registration where membership fees remain outstanding.
- The Club reserves the right to verify membership status at training sessions and matches.
- The Club cannot be held responsible for weather conditions or any other circumstances beyond its control causing postponement of training sessions or scheduled matches.
- Neither Woking Town FC nor any individual acting on behalf of the Club shall be liable for loss of or damage to personal property during Club activities.
- In the event that your child is injured during training, matches, Club activities or travel to and from events, and a parent/carer cannot be contacted, you consent to: Your child receiving first aid treatment from a suitably qualified Club official; and Any emergency medical or dental treatment considered necessary by qualified medical professionals. • You understand the extent and limitations of the insurance cover provided by the Club. - You confirm that the information provided within this membership application is correct and that you will notify the Club immediately of any changes. Information provided will not be disclosed to any third party except where necessary in accordance with the Club's Data Protection Policy.
- In making this application for membership on behalf of a player under the age of 18, you accept full and unconditional liability for payment of all applicable membership fees for the relevant season.

DATA CONSENT
